Thus far this year, FSSA was pleased to award grants to three shooters attending the USA Shooting Junior Olympics in Colorado Springs, CO, one shooter who attended the Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany, and finally one shooter who attended the USA Shooting National championships in Ft. Benning, GA. FSSA was a significant sponsor of Central Florida Rifle and Pistol Club's "Ladies Day at the Range" in April. Over 400 women participated in this fun and informative day of shooting. FSSA will again be a sponsor for Gateway Rifle and Pistol Club's annual "Ladies Day" in November, where it is anticipated that nearly 100 women will participate. Finally, FSSA was able to assist our state teams at the NRA National Pistol Championships as well as the CMP's National Rifle Championships. I look forward to hearing from our individual and team shooters and sharing their accomplishments with you on our FSSA website and via Face Book.

The FSSA Directors are optimistic about the Association's ability to continue supporting and promoting events and shooters; and we are also hoping to expand our grant program to include more individuals and clubs.
